- Continue i-Ready reading and math lessons. You must complete at least 45 minutes in reading and 45 minutes in math. You may do additional time if you wish to.
- ➤ VISIT OUR CLASS WEBPAGE You will need to log into Unified Classroom. There are several ways to log in. Many of the SPS laptops have a fancy P icon on the desktop when you log in. Simply click the P. You can also go to the student app page and look for the fancy P with NO label under it. Students can also access Unified Classroom by entering classroom.powerschool.com into a browser, click Sign in with Microsoft and enter their SPS email and computer password. Here are directions from the district. Once you are logged in, look along the left side of your screen for the words class pages. Click to enter. There are many fun activities and information for families. If you click Communications in the left column, you can find information about assignments.

- Movement breaks, exercise, and calming strategies are important to help you stay safe & healthy.
- Say Hello Parents try to navigate to Unified Classroom (the fancy P), sign in with your child's SPS credentials when asked, look for the kindergarten class page along the left side of your screen. We invite you to explore the class webpage. It is filled with useful sections and resources. You will need to go to our class webpage from Unified Classroom and look for the section called, Say Hello to complete the Say Hello activity. We want each child to access an app called Flipgrid to make a video recording saying hello to their friends and exploring the great features that are available on Flipgrid. You can make your video by scrolling to the bottom of the rectangle box and pressing the green plus sign. This should take you directly into the Flipgrid app.
- Reading & Writing Work— You should read and write every day. You may choose the books to read and what to write about. You must submit at least 1 piece of writing each week. You may do additional writing and share them through Flipgrid or take a photo and send it to us on ClassDojo. The code for Book Talks Flipgrid activity is https://flipgrid.com/b78ebb57. Links are also connected to our Kindergarten class page.

- ➤ Word Work We offer several lists of sight words depending on how many words your child currently knows. The goal is for all kindergarten children to able to read each of the 33 words quickly and accurately. We have a learning sight page on our website. Please visit and find the list of words that is just right for your child. If unsure which list is best for your child, please message us.

- ➤ Being a Reader Set Work Use any materials already provided to you. Teachers will contact you with any new information or lessons relating to Set work. Not all children were given this activity so no worries if it isn't familiar to you.
- Counting We want you to practice counting as high as you can. Visit our website. There is a whole page of videos, a hundred's chart you can download, and a Flipgrid link to show us your counting. We want you to practice this for a few weeks, so you keep growing your skills. You must send us at least one Flipgrid recording of your child counting, but you may redo the recording as many times as you want. No worries if your child cannot count to 100 yet, we are practicing. Great if they can, let them keep going.

- Math Work We are posting video lessons to teach new content addition to 10 and revisit addition as well as subtraction to 5. Our class web page has videos to learn about addition and subtraction. You can also make flash cards to practice. Our web page has a link to a quiz like activity your child might enjoy. This is not required, but many kids find it fun.
