How does the land effect the state?</p> <p>For example, a state with a lot of farms and plains would be able to grow many crops.</p>	<p>Research and write a paragraph about the attractions in your state.</p> <p>What kinds of things do people visit in that state? Are there state forests, museums, beautiful scenery, or any other places people may want to visit?</p>	<p>Write a conclusion for your state paper.</p> <p>Restate some important ideas, for example:</p> <p>Arizona is a very interesting state.
