




Vick had a sick pet. He put the pet in the van. Where was her vet?



The vet saw the pet. He said to mash up her food in a dish.




Vick got his pet back in the van. They went back home.



Val had a sad pet. His shin was cut. They saw his vet.




The pet got a shot. The vet said to put him in his shed.
