




Fran looks for Mom in a log. Sniff, sniff.



It is just a bug.




Fran looks for Mom in a flock. Flap, flap.




It is a flock of ducks. No Mom there.




Fran looks for Mom on the flat rocks.



She sees a frog, but she can't see Mom. Flip, flop.




Fran looks for Mom in the stems.




Flit, flit. It is just a bird.




Fran flops down on the flat dock. Flop, flop.
