- **Continue i-Ready reading and math lessons.** We strongly encourage you to continue i-Ready reading and math lessons through the summer. I-Ready monitors your child's progress and provides an individualized learning path that targets where they are academically and builds the specific skills they need to work on.
- **VISIT OUR CLASS WEBPAGE** – You will need to log into Unified Classroom. There are several ways to log in. Many of the SPS laptops have a fancy P icon on the desktop when you log in. Simply click the P. You can also go to the student app page and look for the fancy P with NO label under it. Students can also access Unified Classroom by entering **classroom.powerschool.com** into a browser, click **Sign in with Microsoft** and enter their SPS email and computer password. Once you are logged in, look along the left side of your screen for the words *class pages*. Click to enter. There are many fun activities along with information for families.
